KEYNOTE SPEECH: REIMAGINING LAW AND TECHNOLOGY

Technology is reshaping our world in fundamentally transformative ways, and at a rate that often outpaces our ability to fully anticipate and comprehend its implications. This has profound consequences for our legal system and its capacity to embrace and support technological change, while guarding against the risks that this may pose to the pursuit of justice. Striking an effective balance between these competing interests demands that we reimagine the relationship between law and technology in bold and proactive ways.

This keynote speech will endeavour to reimagine the interface between law and technology across three key dimensions. First, it will explore how the courts might harness technology's potential to drive institutional change and strengthen the administration of justice. It will then examine how legal technology may come to redefine the role of the modern legal professional and transform the delivery of legal services. Furthermore, we will navigate the complex regulatory environment for cross-border cryptocurrency projects, with a focus on the critical aspects of KYC and AML compliance for Decentralized Finance (DeFi) applications. Finally, our panellists will analyse the implications of the White House's stance on cryptocurrencies, as articulated in the Digital Assets Summit & Strategic Reserve and Digital Asset Stockpile initiatives and discuss their potential impact on the Asian crypto market. This panel will provide invaluable insights into the current legal challenges and future directions of crypto law.


