TRAVELLING TO THE PHILIPPINES

Protocols

All arriving and departing passengers must register via the eTravel Portal at <https://etravel.gov.ph>. Participants may also download the app via their mobile application stores.

Participants may register within 72 hours prior to arrival or departure in the Philippines. Registration to site is free of charge.

Airport Arrival/Departure (*Terminal updates effective 29 March 2026*)

Ninoy Aquino International Airport (NAIA) is the recommended port of entry and departure for the conference period.

Visa Requirements

Participants are required to obtain an appropriate entry visa from the Embassy of the Republic of the Philippines before entering the Philippines except for those listed as visa-free.

Participants not included in the visa-free list may proceed to apply for a 9(a) Temporary Visitor’s Visa at the nearest Philippine Embassy or Consulate in their country of origin/legal residence.

Requirements for Issuance of Temporary Visitor’s Visa

1. Duly accomplished visa application form (FA Form No. 2) with a passport-size photograph taken during the last six (6) months
2. Passport valid for at least six (6) months beyond authorized period of stay in the Philippines
3. Tickets or flight reservation (entry and exit)
4. For business purposes, letter from employer or sponsor (which may be the inviting in the Philippines) indicating the specific purpose of travel, length of stay (inclusive dates), and company guarantee for all moral and financial obligations to be incurred by the applicant while in the Philippines
5. Proof of Income
6. Hotel accommodation or proof of lodging

Airport Courtesy/Diplomatic Lanes

Airport courtesy lanes for all ICN delegates and their companions are available to expedite the arrival process. Interested parties should supply the following information to be forwarded to the Bureau of Immigration for advance verification:

- Arrival and Departure Flight Details. Includes name of airline, flight numbers, dates of arrival and departure, assigned airport terminals
- Passport Biopage. Contains the passport number and signature. Please remember to include the passport biopage of companions.

The sign-up form for the airport courtesy lane and airport shuttle service (Travel and Logistics Information form) can be found in the Registration Confirmation emails you have received (*SUBJECT: Confirmation of Registration – 2026 ICN Annual Conference in Manila, Philippines*). Kindly note that sign-in is required due to the file upload component. Should you have problems accessing the form, please inform the Organizing Committee via reg.icnmnl@phcc.gov.ph.

Please look for the Diplomatic, ASEAN, or APEC lanes at the immigration counters in Terminals 1 and 3. Note that only travelers who have registered and provided their flight details in advance are permitted to use these lanes.

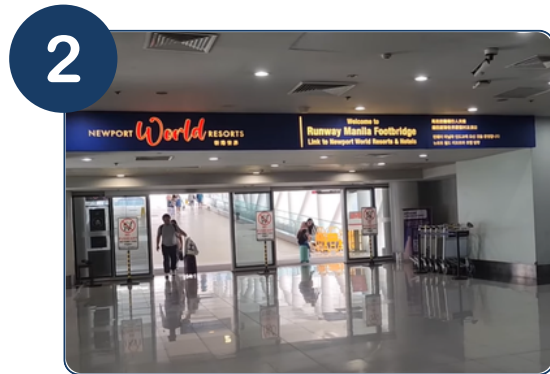
Utilize the centralized ride-hailing hub located at the multi-level parking building



Another option for delegates arriving at Terminal 3 is to take the Runway Manila going to Manila Marriott Hotel and other accommodations within Newport City.



From NAIA Terminal 3, proceed toward the departure hall area and follow the overhead signs leading to Runway Manila



Continue walking and follow the overhead signs directing you to Runway Manila/Newport City



Enter the covered skybridge and walk straight along the waitlist pathway.



Exit at the end of the bridge leading to the Newport City area.

Alternatively, there is an available shuttle that can take you to your accommodation within Newport City free of charge.

OTHER INFORMATION

Time Zone

The Philippine Standard Time is 8 hours ahead of GMT (GMT +8).

Weather

The average temperature during May typically ranges from 26°C (79°F) at night to 34°C (93°F) during the day. It's generally one of the hottest months of the year, with high humidity (often over 70%) and occasional afternoon thunderstorms as the country approaches the start of the rainy season in June.

Currency

The official currency of the Philippines is the Philippine Peso (PhP). Retailers in the Philippines do not accept other currencies. Delegates may wish to change their currencies at the airport after clearing immigration or customs or at exchange counters near the hotel for better rates. Major international credit cards are widely accepted.

Internet Connection

Guests can enjoy free public Wi-Fi in many parts of the Philippines. Major airports also provide high-speed, unlimited Wi-Fi. Complimentary internet is also available in many malls, cafés, hotels, and transport terminals. Wi-Fi at the conference venue will also be available.

For more reliable connectivity, guests can purchase a local prepaid SIM or eSIM from major telecom providers. Physical SIMs are available at airport kiosks, official telco shops, and convenience stores, while eSIMs can be bought online before arrival via global platforms.

Power Plugs and Sockets

Power plugs and sockets in the Philippines use Type A and Type B connectors. The standard voltage is 220V with a frequency of 60Hz. Travelers are advised to bring a universal power adapter to ensure compatibility with local outlets.



Smoking Areas

Metro Manila implements designated smoking places policy. This imposes stiff penalties and other sanctions in violation of this ordinance. However, designated areas in public places and selected establishments are also provided. Please check with your booked accommodation for designated smoking places.
